- **Individual Paper Presentation:** 20 minutes including 10 minutes of Q&A
- **Self-Organized Symposium:** 90 minutes around a common theme with a moderator (symposia will be accepted if the presenters are at least three people)
- **Poster Presentation:** 20 minutes with the speaker available to discuss with participants
- **Workshop:** 90 minutes


