LORIS MALAGUZZI INTERNATIONAL CENTRE

The Loris Malaguzzi International Centre is a place for dialogue and exchange for all those who seek to innovate education and culture—in Reggio Emilia, in Italy, and around the world. It is an open space for all ages, ideas, and cultures, which, starting from the experience of the municipal infant-toddler centres and preschools, fosters research, innovation, and experimentation in educational content and processes for ages 0 to 99. A true manifesto of the Reggio Emilia Approach. The Centre is housed in the buildings that, for over half a century, were home to the historic Locatelli company and its Parmigiano-Reggiano warehouses.



CAFFARRI

A place that once housed the carpentry workshop of the Officine Meccaniche Reggiane and later a feed mill has been transformed into a space dedicated to research, education, and sustainability—engaging in dialogue with the neighborhood, the city, and communities around the world. Fondazione Reggio Children has chosen to situate its research in this expansive space, rich in history yet contemporary in spirit, focusing on quality education, solidarity, regeneration, social and environmental sustainability, and creative learning—seeking interactions, synergies, and the involvement of new partners. The first projects hosted by FRC in this large central nave include the PER – Play Explore Research project, *scintillae* – play and learning in the digital age in collaboration with The LEGO Foundation, the Reggio Childhood Studies PhD with DESU-Unimore, and Remida, the Creative Recycling Center.
